

## Rules of the Carolina Brewery Market, 2010

1. Annual member fee is \$30.00 (this includes two daily parking fees). Members are required to pay a \$5.00 daily parking fee; members may opt to pay \$100.00 for the year (this includes the annual member fee).

2. New vendors must submit their applications, pay the membership fee plus a \$25 non-refundable application fee, and either have their farms inspected or provide prior inspection documentation in order to be considered for membership. Application fees do not apply to returning vendors.

3. The market manager reserves the right to re-inspect any member. In addition, the market manager reserves the right to revoke a membership to the Carolina Brewery Farmer's market for failure to follow these rules or for acting in a way that is detrimental to the market.

4. There will be two formal market meetings, one in the spring and one in the fall. Dates and times for these meetings will be announced two weeks before they take place.

5. The first market will be on Saturday, April 24, 2010. The market will be open each successive Saturday ending on Saturday, November 20, 2010. The final market will be on Wednesday, November 24, 2010 from 10am -2pm.

6. The market will open from 8am – 12:30 pm on Saturdays at the Carolina Brewery and Grill parking lot, unless otherwise noted.

7. A vendor must make or produce what he/she sells within a 50-mile radius of the market. All products must be of top quality.

8. Products that **can** be sold are:

- Vegetables grown from seeds, sets or seedlings.
- Fruits, nuts or berries grown on land owned or leased by the seller.
- Plants grown by the seller from seed, seedling, transplant or cutting.
- Bulbs propagated by the seller.
- Eggs produced from the seller's hens
- Meats from animals raised by the seller.
- Products from animals raised by the seller.
- Honey produced from the seller's bees.
- Cut or dried flowers grown by the seller.
- Firewood cut by the seller.
- Straw baled by the seller.
- Preserves, pickles, relishes, jams and jellies made by the seller.

9. Products that **cannot** be sold are:

- Baked goods of any kind.
- Canned goods.
- Live animals (cannot be sold **or** given away).

10. All products under certification such as organic, licensed meat, poultry, or dairy products or products requiring inspection, such as preserves, must display certification or license and have a copy on file with the Market Manager.

11. The seller is responsible for cleaning up around his/her vehicle and maintaining safety in that area.

12. Any complaints, disputes or violations of the rules may be taken to the market manager. This should be handled before or after the market so as not to interrupt market sales. Repeated violations of the rules of the Carolina Brewery Market may result in suspension or loss of membership. All rules are open to the interpretation of the manager and owner.

Applications will be accepted with a check equal to the annual membership fee + application fee for new vendors. The manager will review applications, complete inspections, and approve each application. Acceptance to the market depends on approved inspection and, as stated, manager approval. Returning vendors do not need to re-apply, but must pay their annual member fees

Please bring suggestions to the market manager. Any written suggestions will be addressed within 30 days. Any resolution will be up to the manager's discretion.
